Student Contract for Chromebook Use

Equipment Subject to Agreement: The Equipment subject to this Agreement (“Contract”) includes the Chromebook and computer accessories in the following list:

- One (1) Google Chromebook - \$350
- One (1) AC Adapter (with power cord) - \$35

Use of Equipment: The primary use of the Equipment by the Student is for the Student’s educational programs. The Student may use the Equipment for other purposes only to the extent that such uses do not interfere with these primary uses and are approved by the teacher/school.

1. The Chromebook is the property of Pickering Christian School.
2. I will **only** use my Chromebook in ways that are educationally appropriate according to my teacher.
3. I will always be respectful, kind and gentle to my Chromebook.
4. I will know where my Chromebook is at all times and never leave the Chromebook unattended.
5. I am only permitted to use the Chromebook and account assigned to me.
6. I will always carry my Chromebook with the screen closed.
7. I will always use my Chromebook in a safe place (sitting down).
8. I will keep food and beverages away from my Chromebook.
9. I will not change any settings (other than the desktop background as approved by my teacher.)
10. I will not disassemble any part of my Chromebook or attempt any repairs.
11. I will not place decorations (such as stickers, markers, etc.) on the Chromebook.
12. I will not use my Chromebook in any inappropriate way (ect. obscene, vulgar, harassing).
13. I will report damage to the Chromebook to my teacher immediately, or risk losing my Chromebook privileges.
14. I understand that if I cause damage to the Chromebook, I will lose Chromebook privileges until the device is repaired or replaced.
15. I will bring the Chromebook to school fully charged every day. (Grade 6-8)

Forgotten, lost, or damaged Chromebook may result in:

- a. Students using a replacement, if available.
- b. All assignments being completed on a desktop or with paper/pen.

Parents: Outside of school, parents bear responsibility for the same guidance of Chromebook use. Parents are responsible for monitoring their student’s use of this device outside of school hours.

If a student breaches any of the above guidelines, the following consequences may apply:

1. The user shall be prohibited from using the school Chromebook.
2. The student will be asked to make financial restitution for any physical damage.
3. In incidents involving the downloading of viruses, illegal software or breach of network security, the student shall have computer privileges revoked for the remainder of the term and/or be suspended from school.

I have read and discussed with my parent/guardian the *Pickering Christian School Student Contract for Chromebook Use*. I understand that inappropriate use of information technologies may result in the withdrawal of privileges and/or other sanctions.
