## Students are to bring their own lunch.

- ROUTE: We will be walking through subdivisions near the school. Children are asked to respect people's property and to STAY ON THE SIDEWALK.
- TREASURE HUNT: Classes will be engaged during the walk participating in a treasure hunt for special items.
- SAFETY: All children will be walking in groups with at least one adult per group. Some parents will be driving the routes slowly to allow any children having difficulty completing the course to return to school. Water stations will be set up at frequent intervals where cold water will be offered to the children.
- DRESS: Each class is discussing a common theme or outfit for the day. Watch for a note coming home with each child for details. This will be a non-uniform day. Also, hats need to be worn and sunscreen applied. Rain date will be posted, if necessary.

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
